The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) Hawai'i Section is pleased to announce the 2023 Outstanding Civil Engineering Achievement (OCEA) Award winners. The purpose of this award program is to recognize projects that demonstrate important outstanding civil engineering accomplishments by Hawai'i's design and construction professionals. To be eligible, projects were required to have been designed or constructed in Hawai'i and completed within the last two years. Some of the key judging criteria included: resourcefulness in planning and solving design challenges; contributions to the well-being of people and communities; pioneering use of materials and methods; innovations in construction; minimization of impact on physical environment; and composite application.

The following projects and project teams were honored and presented with awards at the ASCE Hawai'i Section OCEA Awards Ceremony, which was held on Thursday, September 21 at the Koʻolau Ballrooms. Congratulations to our winners!



The Kapa'a Stream Bridge and Kūhiō Highway/ Ma'ilihuna Road Roundabout project stands as a testament to unique and outstanding civil engineering accomplishments. The project's construction innovations, exemplified by visionary roundabout design and integration of GRS abutments, harmoniously blend advanced engineering and environmental consciousness, preserving aesthetics and history. The project's design ability and meticulous execution signify more than just building infrastructure—it symbolizes progressive respect for the past and an embrace of the future.

2023 Best Studies and Research Project Project Name: Future Stability & Adaptation Under Sea Level Rise at Hilo Breakwater: A Numerical Assessment Utilizing Computational Fluid Dynamics

Project Owner: **US Army Corps of Engineers** Submitted by: **Sea Engineering, Inc.**

The Hilo Breakwater extends more than 10,000 feet from the Hilo shoreline into the bay, forming the protected inner harbor. The rubble-mound breakwater was constructed in the early 1900s over the course of nearly 25 years to provide a sheltered environment for the Hilo Deep Draft Harbor. Using Computational Fluid Dynamics, the current project provided an in-depth analysis of the breakwater's performance and armor stone stability under present and future wave conditions and rising sea levels, using high resolution three-dimensional computational fluid dynamics models.




2023 Best Building/Structural Project Project Name: Koʻula High Rise Project Owner: Howard Hughes Submitted bv: BASE

Koʻula is a 41-story mixed-use development featuring 942,000 square feet of built area, including a 566-unit residential tower, common and amenity spaces, 58,300 square feet of retail space and six stories of abovegrade parking. Koula means "red sugar cane" and inspired the undulating sculpted structural columns at its exterior façade, evoking the twisting nature of the sugar cane reeds prominent in Hawai'i. Koʻula is an iconic structure to serve as a hub for Ward Village's residents and prominently anchor the development's central park.

Project Name: Waiāhole Potable Water **System Emergency Repairs**

Project Owner: Hawai'i Housing Finance and **Development Corporation**

The Hawai'i Housing Finance and Development Corporation (HHFDC) owns and maintains aprivate potable water system which provides domestic and agricultural water for the Waiāhole Valley Agricultural Park and Residential Lots Subdivision. The water system is the sole source of potable water for the area. After a large storm caused extensive damage to the site and halted the system's continued operation, Okahara was able to shift focus, complete the emergency repair package, receive contractor bids within forty-four days, and complete the repairs within a year.

Wailuku-Kahului Wastewater Reclamation Facility (W-K WWRF) plays a crucial role in serving the economic heart of Maui by treating wastewater and discharging treated effluent, protecting the recreational waters for residents and visitors. The project developed the W-K WWRF Facility Plan to establish the level of service goals and requirements for the facility through the planning horizon of 2050. The Plan evaluated the W-K WWRF's condition, capacity, and reliability to provide a roadmap for recommended improvements.

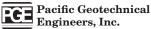
