

HAWAII BEGINS THE LICENSURE OF FIRE PROTECTION ENGINEERS

On September 12, 2023 Hawaii Governor Josh Green signed off on revisions to Chapter 16-155 of the Hawaii Administrative Rules governing the Hawaii State Board of Professional Engineers, Architects, Surveyors, and Landscape Architects (PEASLA). Those revisions include provisions for licensure of fire protection engineers. Hawaii becomes the 50th and final state in the U. S. to recognize the discipline of fire protection engineering through licensure. Better late than never.

This marks the successful conclusion of an on-again/off-again lobbying effort by Hawaii Chapter SFPE over the past 32 years ago. Lobbying efforts were continued several times over the next several years. In 2010 and 2013 then SFPE Engineering Programs Manager Chris Jelenewicz traveled to Honolulu to provide testimony to PEASLA in support of FPE licensure.

The real credit should go to current PEASLA Board Members Kevin Katayama, PE and Dan Hirota, PE, for ensuring the rule change successfully navigated the bureaucracy. No small feat given our previous decades of disappointment. Kevin, who is president of Kevin Katayama & Associates, is Vice-Chair and the current the mechanical engineering rep on the board. Kevin is also a member of the Hawaii Chapter SFPE and a licensed FPE (in another state). Dan is the surveyor rep on the board and works for Coffman Engineers, Inc.

Many others also deserve thanks, including Robert Bigtas, PE and Lisa Koshimizu, PE, who as young engineers at SSDA, Inc. researched the status of FPE licensures in all 50 states and developed extensive justifications. The critical support of George Nishimura, PE, former structural engineer rep on PEASLA helped revive the effort in the late 1990's. Joe Condlin, PE, former Chief FPE at PACDIV, now known as NAVFAC PAC, was instrumental in bringing the influence of the Navy FPE program to bear on the issue.

It is our understanding that the first two engineers to receive the Hawaii FPE license are Kevin Katayama and Sam Dannaway.

When asked about this seminal event Sam Dannaway said, "I am thankful for the vigilance of supporters of this effort over the many years. It saddens me that it took so long though I am grateful it occurred before my official retirement, it is the 'Cherry on the Top'".

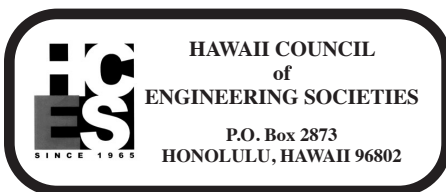

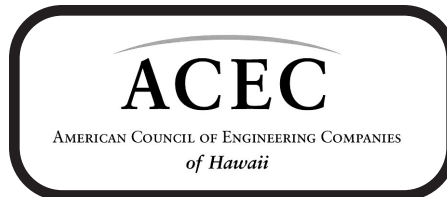

IEEE DL Seminar - Cognitive RF Systems: Using AI to Solve Complex Problems

This presentation by Dr. Karen Haigh will introduce a broad overview of how artificial intelligence (AI) can be used in complex radio frequency systems. AI enables RF systems to respond more quickly and effectively to dynamic environment conditions with complex and novel emitters. Karen will illustrate where the AI techniques of situation assessment, decision making, and machine learning can function in an RF system, and show how Cognitive Radio, Cognitive Radar and Cognitive Electronic Warfare are the same concept. She will describe how to handle real-time in-mission learning, motivate why this capability is crucial, and present ideas on how to evaluate a system that learns during a mission. Skills Development Seminars for Women in Engineering

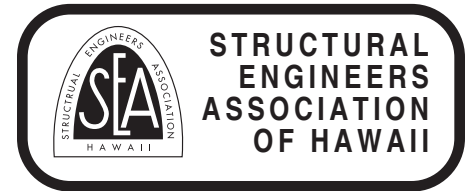
In a bid to foster professional growth and empower women in the engineering field, IEEE Hawaii Women in Engineering (WIE) recently hosted two impactful seminars.

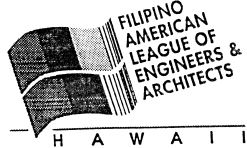

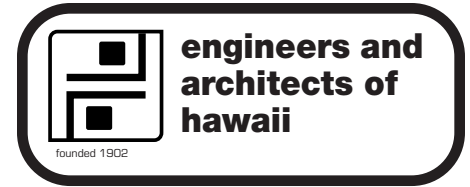

Two IEEE Humanitarian projects demonstrate with 4 case studies how to bring Energy Equity and Resilience/Safety to Native Hawaiian communities on Molokai, Native Hawaiian Homesteaders living off-grid and Native Hawaiian low-income renters without access to rooftop solar. For Homesteaders, Solar + Battery and energy efficient household appliances were used. For low-income renters a Plug-n-Play Solar-Battery generator, ground mount solar array and wind turbine with IoT digitized smart devices for monitor and control were used. Energy burdens were reduced by up to 91% and 65% respectively.

Title is "Reflections on Reflections."

Reflective roofs and walls, including non-white coatings, are perhaps the most resource-efficient and cost-effective means of cooling Hawaii's homes and buildings. 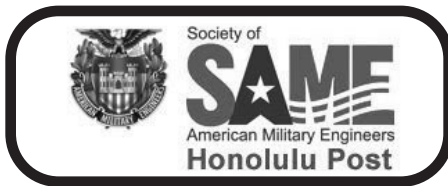

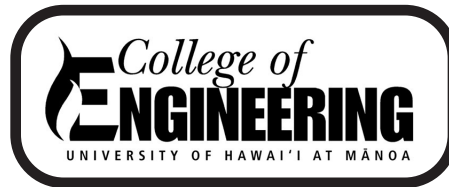

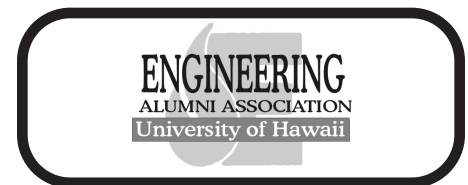
